



Temporary left turn restriction (weekdays 3 p.m. – 6 p.m.) from Memorial Drive to McBride Boulevard

April 16, 2024

Starting April 17, the left turn from Memorial Drive to McBride Boulevard southbound (towards the Pattullo Bridge) will be temporarily restricted on weekdays between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. This left turn restriction will be in effect while the current Columbia Street closure is in place. This temporary turning restriction is to reduce local congestion and to ensure that emergency responders, community members, and businesses have unrestricted access to local streets. Right-in and right-out access on Memorial Drive, as well as the southbound left turn from McBride Boulevard to Memorial Drive, will be maintained and traffic control personnel will be on-site as required to assist with traffic operations. All existing movements at E. Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard will be maintained, with inbound movements signed for “local access only”.

Access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained at all times via McBride Boulevard (Bridge Connector) and the Royal Avenue on-ramp. Drivers travelling westbound on E. Columbia Street will be detoured at Braid Street to access the Pattullo Bridge via Bridge Connector. Drivers can also take Front Street to Royal Avenue to access the bridge.

Timing

Starting April 17 and continuing throughout the Columbia Street closure.



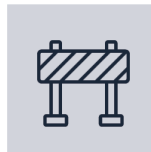
Hours of Work

Weekdays between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. while the Columbia Street closure is in effect.



Traffic

Drivers travelling westbound on E. Columbia Street will be detoured at Braid Street to access the Pattullo Bridge. Right-in and right-out access at Memorial Drive, as well as the southbound left turn from McBride Boulevard onto Memorial Drive, will be maintained at all times. Inbound access at E. Royal Avenue will be signed for local traffic only. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed and traffic control personnel will be on-site to assist as required to support vehicles not turning left from Memorial Drive to access the Pattullo Bridge.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists may experience longer than normal travel times.
