



Nighttime utility work and temporary restriction in and out of Granville Street at Royal Avenue

May 7, 2024

Starting Tuesday, May 7, crews will be installing underground utilities on Royal Avenue across Granville Street. This work will take place for approximately three nights.

While this work is underway, access in and out of Granville Street at Royal Avenue will be temporarily restricted between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Access to residences on Granville Street will be maintained via 1st Street.

Excavation activities are required as part of this work; however, this work is not expected to be noisy.

Starting Tuesday, May 7 and continuing for approximately three nights.



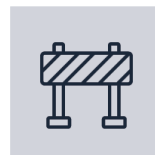
Hours of Work
