



Underground utility work on Dufferin Street at Royal Avenue

UPDATED: June 27, 2024

Starting the week of July 2, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground utility work on Dufferin Street at Royal Avenue for approximately two weeks. This work was originally scheduled to begin June 17; however, the work was rescheduled.

While this work is underway, pedestrian and cyclist access between Royal Avenue and Dufferin Street will be temporarily restricted. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to Coburg Street.

Dufferin Street will remain open via Agnes Street for residents and access to driveways will be maintained. Vehicle access between Dufferin Street and Royal Avenue remains permanently closed.

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, hydrovaccing, and other machinery during the day. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.

Starting the week of July 2 and continuing for approximately two weeks.



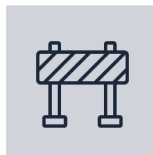
Hours of Work
