



Nighttime utility and road work on Royal Avenue at McBride Boulevard and on Bridge Connector

UPDATED: July 29, 2024

Ongoing nighttime utility and road work near the Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard intersection will continue the week of July 29.

Starting the week of August 6, crews will move to Bridge Connector to conduct additional nighttime utility and road work just north of the Royal Avenue overpass. This work will also take approximately one week to complete.

Construction activities such as excavation, backfilling, and road paving are required for both works and may result in periods of noise.

Temporary nighttime lane closures on Royal Avenue and Bridge Connector will be required. When closures are in place, one lane will remain open in each direction.

Ongoing and continuing for approximately two weeks.



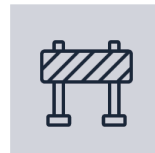
Hours of Work

Traffic

Nighttime lane closures on Royal Avenue and Bridge Connector. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.
