Upcoming construction activities in Surrey

The following is an overview of upcoming construction activities and traffic pattern changes planned in Surrey for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project.

When lane closures and detours are required, work will be done at night, where feasible, to minimize impacts to drivers. Work that does not impact traffic will generally be performed between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

1. South Approach bridge deck construction – ongoing into summer

Finishing works to complete the bridge deck structure in Surrey are ongoing, including the removal of formwork and the installation of utilities and fencing. Occasional overnight closures of Highway 17 between Tannery Road and Bridgeview Drive will be required. Nighttime closures of 112/111A Avenue, Bridge Road, and Musqueam Drive will also be required.

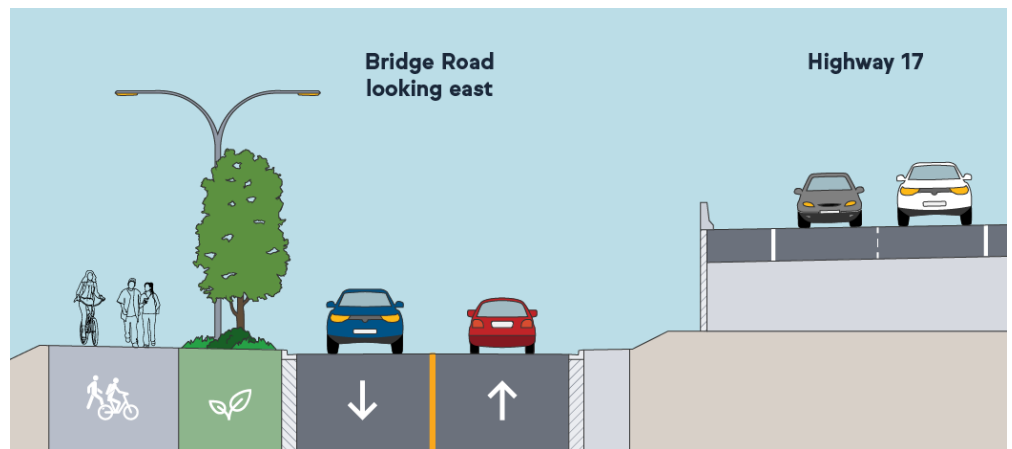
2. Construction of the new Highway 17 off-ramp and multi-use paths – ongoing through summer

Girder installation is ongoing and will be followed by deck panel installation. Construction of the structures for the new multi-use path connection to Highway 17 is also ongoing. Nighttime closures of Bridge Road, Old Yale Road, and overnight directional closures of Highway 17 westbound will be required to complete this work.

3. Roadwork to upgrade Bridge Road to two-way traffic – ongoing through summer

Roadwork is underway to upgrade Bridge Road from one-way to two-way traffic. Once complete, Bridge Road will be widened and westbound vehicles will have a new connection from Industrial Road to Old Yale Road.

Once complete, Bridge Road will also feature a new multi-use path for pedestrians and cyclists connecting to the Scott Greenway and new bridge.

4. Roadwork and multi-use path construction on 112 Avenue and King George Boulevard – ongoing through summer

112 Avenue has been graded and paved, and construction of the curbs, new sidewalk, and multi-use path is ongoing. Construction of the embankment wall and bridge approach alongside King George Boulevard is also underway.
