Construction Update

- 56 of 80 cable stays installed
- South approach bridge deck complete
- North approach bridge deck underway
- Highway 17 / Old Yale Road overpass open to traffic in both directions

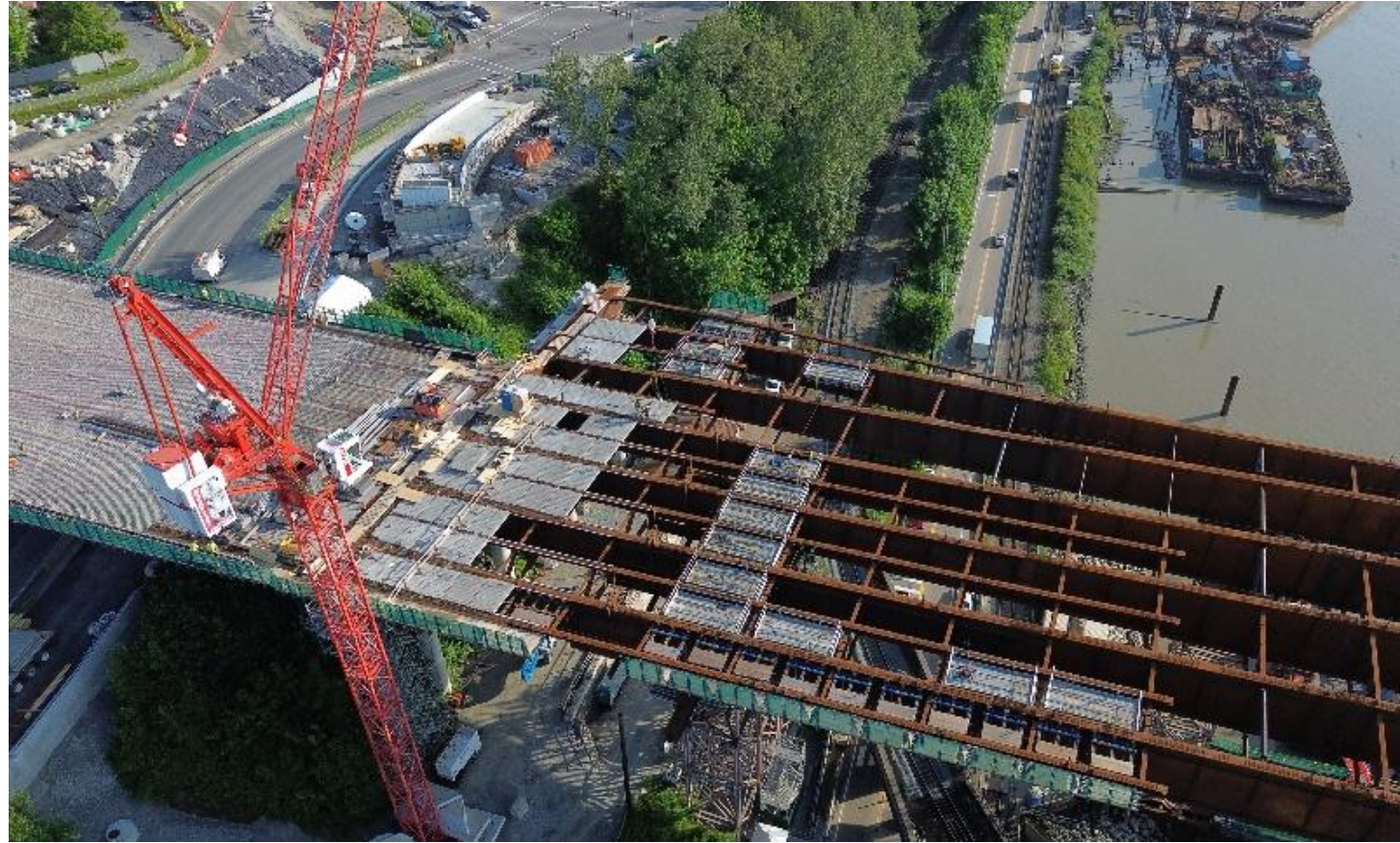

Bridge Deck Construction in New Westminster

- Ongoing installation of overhang brackets, steel bracing, deck panels, and precast panels over Front Street
- Overnight closures of Front Street and Columbia Street required
- Summer: Concrete deck pours, removal of formwork and the installation of finishings
- Fall: Completion of finishings above Columbia Street and Front Street

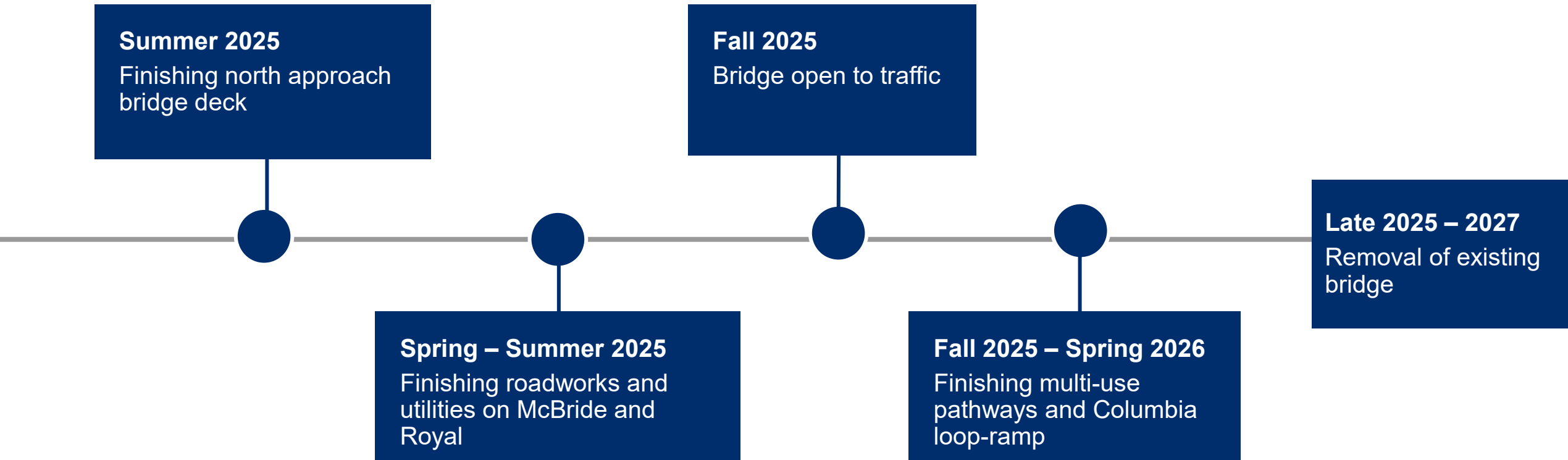

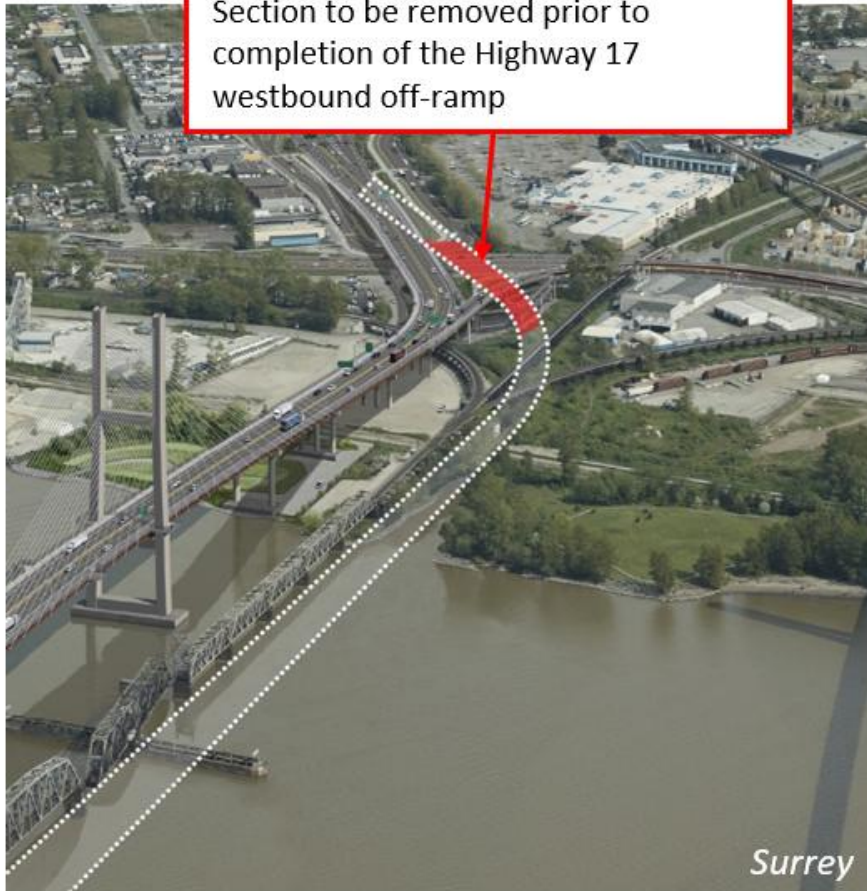

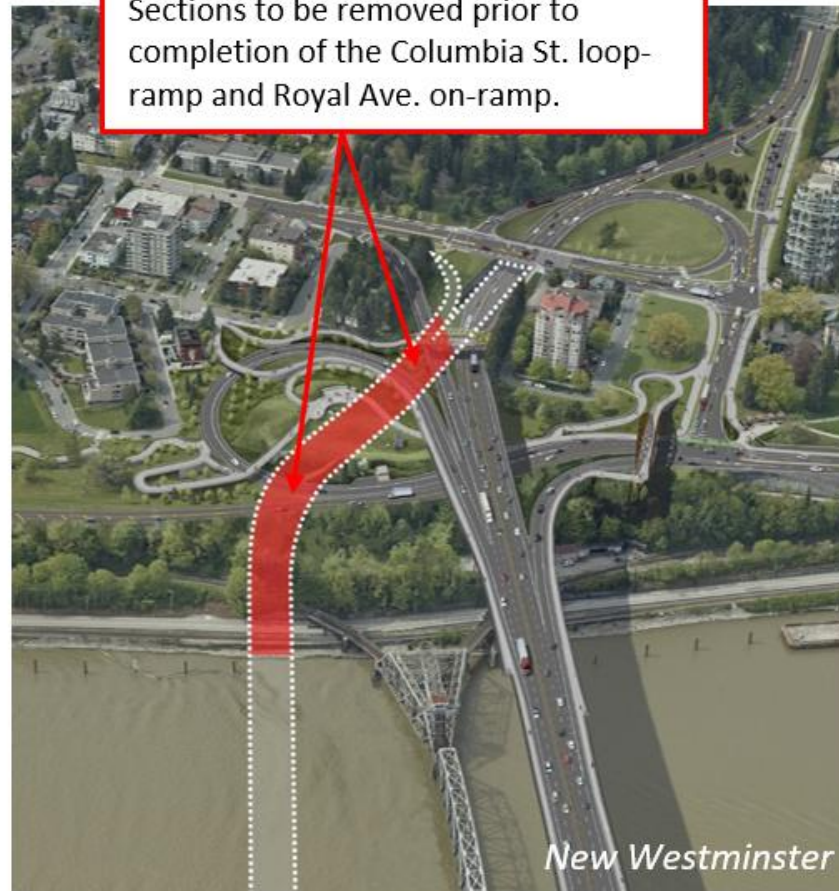
Bridge Opening and Bridge Removal

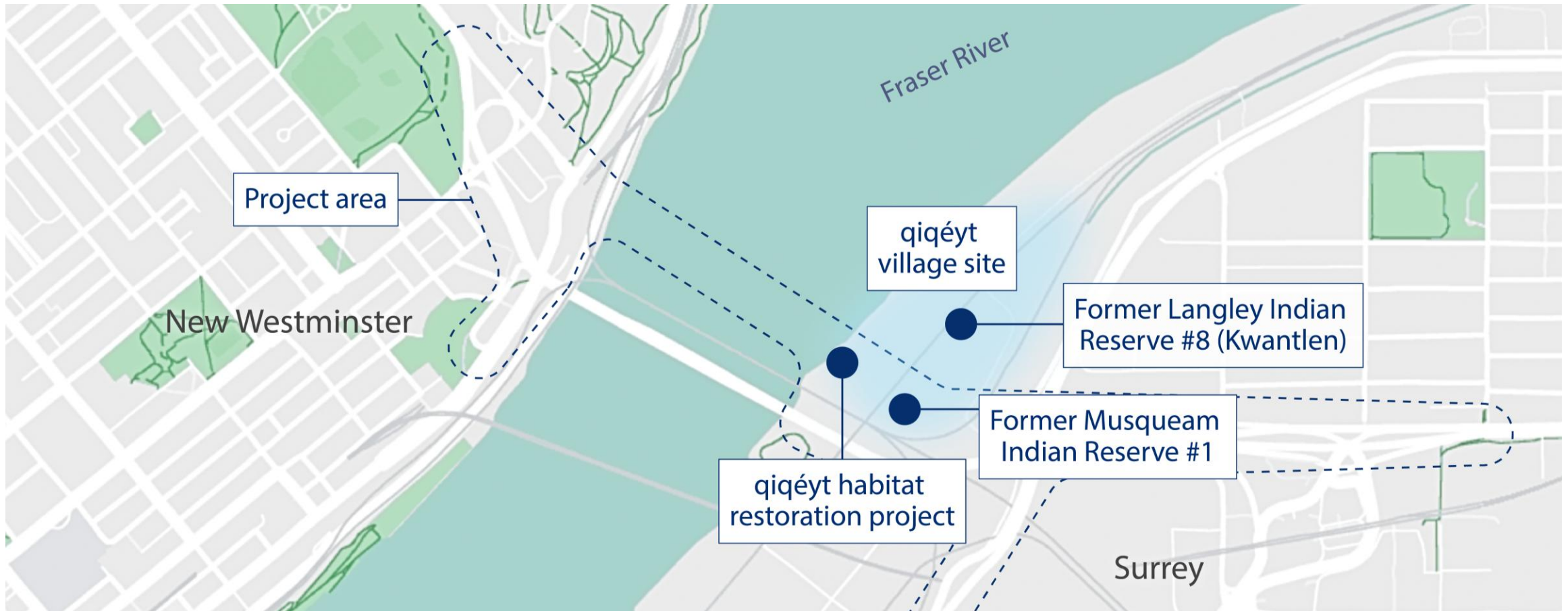

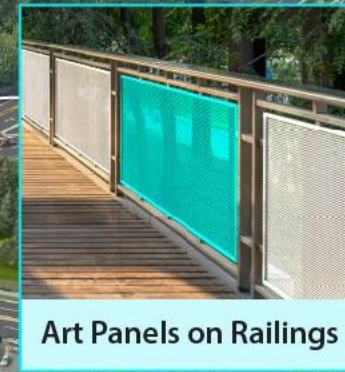

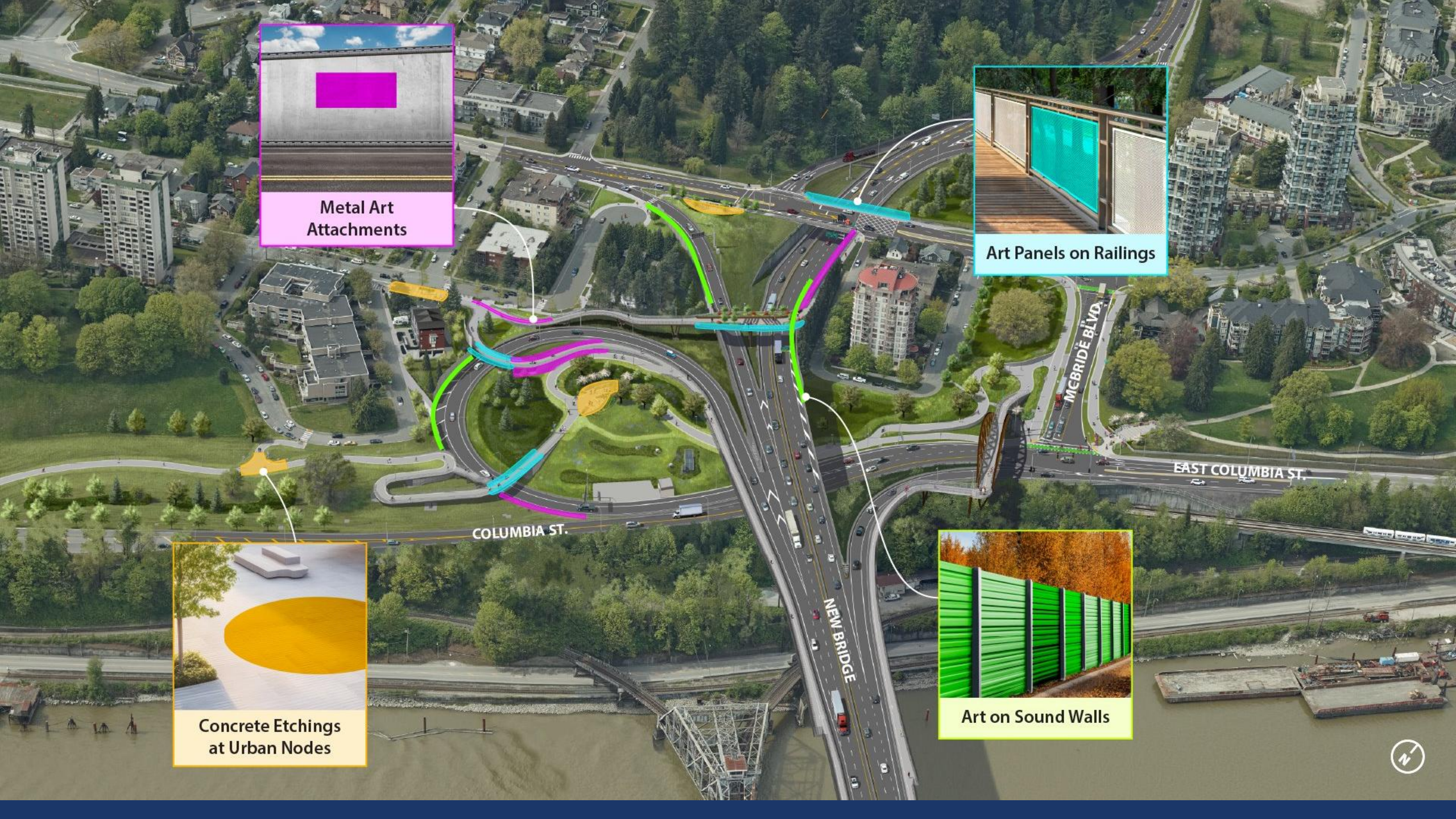
