



Underground utility work and multi-use pathway construction on McBride Boulevard

July 4, 2025

Starting the week of July 7, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground utility work and begin constructing the multi-use pathway (MUP) on the west side of McBride Boulevard between Columbia Street and Royal Avenue. This work will take place in stages throughout summer.

To complete this work, the traffic lanes on McBride Boulevard northbound will be adjusted to the permanent configuration. McBride Boulevard northbound will be reduced to a single lane near Columbia Street, with two lanes maintained at the Royal Avenue intersection. Two lanes on McBride Boulevard southbound will remain open.

Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the east sidewalk for the duration of these work activities, and detour routes will be clearly marked.

Construction activities such as excavation, saw cutting, and concrete pours are required to complete this work and may result in periods of noise. A small amount of hydrovac work will be required.

Hours of Work

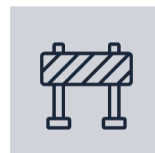
Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, heavy equipment, and occasional hydrovac work.
