





Sidewalk construction on Royal Avenue

July 16, 2025

Starting the week of July 21, Fraser Crossing Partners will be constructing the new sidewalk on the south side of Royal Avenue between 1st Street and Bushby Street. This work will take approximately three weeks to complete.

While this work is underway, the existing sidewalk on the south side of Royal Avenue will be temporarily closed. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the new sidewalk on the north side of Royal Avenue. Access will be maintained for residents on Leopold Place and Bushby Street.

To assist pedestrians travelling along Royal Avenue, two new pedestrian activated crosswalks have been installed for the new crossings at the Royal Avenue loop-ramp and at McBride Boulevard.

Timing

Starting the week of July 21 and continuing for approximately three weeks.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.
