





# Foundation construction for new overhead signs in New Westminster

# August 21, 2025

Starting the week of August 25, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin building the foundations for eleven new overhead and roadside guide signs at various locations in New Westminster, including alongside Bridge Connector, Royal Avenue, Columbia Street, McBride Boulevard, and the Royal Avenue loop-ramp. These signs will help direct drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians to the new bridge.

Building the foundations for each sign will take approximately two to three days to complete. For some sign locations, hydrovaccing, sawcutting, and drilled shaft activities will be required. This work will be conducted 24 hours a day, and hydrovaccing and sawcutting activities will be completed by 10 p.m. Temporary lane closures at the various locations, as well as temporary full closures of the Royal Avenue off-ramp from southbound Bridge Connector, will be required.

# What to Expect



### **Timing**

Starting August 25 and continuing into fall.



#### **Hours of Work**

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day.

Hydrovaccing and sawcutting activities will be completed by 10 p.m.



## Traffic

Temporary lane closures will be required on Bridge Connector, Royal Avenue, Columbia Street, McBride Boulevard, and the Royal Avenue loop-ramp. Temporary full closures of the Royal Avenue off-ramp from southbound Bridge Connector will also be required. Traffic control personnel will be onsite to direct traffic, cyclists, and pedestrians as required.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from the hydrovaccing, sawcutting, and installation activities.
