





UPDATED: Closure of Bridge Road extended to September


August 8, 2025

Bridge Road will remain closed until early September so crews can continue roadworks to upgrade the road from one-way to two-way traffic. These activities started in late May and include work on the new direct Highway 17 off-ramp.

While this closure is in effect, traffic will be detoured via 120 Street and Bridgeview Drive to access 116 Avenue, Industrial Road, and Musqueam Drive. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers when required.

Once complete, Bridge Road will be widened and westbound vehicles will have a new connection via Bridge Road from Industrial Road to Old Yale Road. As seen in the illustration to the right, a new multi-use path on the north side of Bridge Road will provide dedicated space for pedestrians and cyclists, and will connect to the Scott Greenway and new bridge. Further notice will be provided once this work is complete and the road opens to two-way traffic.
