





House demolition on Wellington Street

August 18, 2025

Starting Tuesday, August 19, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin demolishing a house at the corner of Wellington Street and Hastings Street that has previously been used as a Project office. The removal of this house is required to prepare the area for construction of the new Columbia Street loop-ramp.

To complete this work, the lower section of Hastings Street at the intersection with Albert Crescent will be closed for approximately one week. Access for residents will be maintained at all times.

Crews will use heavy equipment to dismantle the structure and remove material.

Timing

Starting Tuesday August 19 and continuing into the fall



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. Saturdays from 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.



Traffic

Hastings Street will be closed at the intersection with Albert Crescent for approximately one week. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists as required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Parking restrictions will be in place starting 3 days in advance of the closure of the lower section of Hastings Street at the intersection with Albert Crescent. Access for residents will be maintained at all times.

Nearby residents may hear noise from demolition activities.
