





Nighttime lane closures alongside King George Boulevard and on 120 Street/Scott Road for paving activities

Starting the night of Sunday, August 24, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting nighttime paving activities alongside King George Boulevard and on 120 Street/Scott Road in Surrey. This work will take approximately one week to complete.

While this work is underway, nighttime lane closures will be required. Temporary parking restrictions will also be in effect. Please watch for signage.

Milling activities will be required in advance of paving and may result in periods of noise. Noisy work will be completed as early in the evenings as possible.

Traffic

Nighttime lane closures alongside King George Boulevard and on 120 Street/Scott Road will be required. Please watch for signage. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists as required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary parking restrictions will be in effect. Nearby residents and businesses may hear intermittent noise from milling and paving activities.
