

# Foundation construction for new overhead signs in Surrey

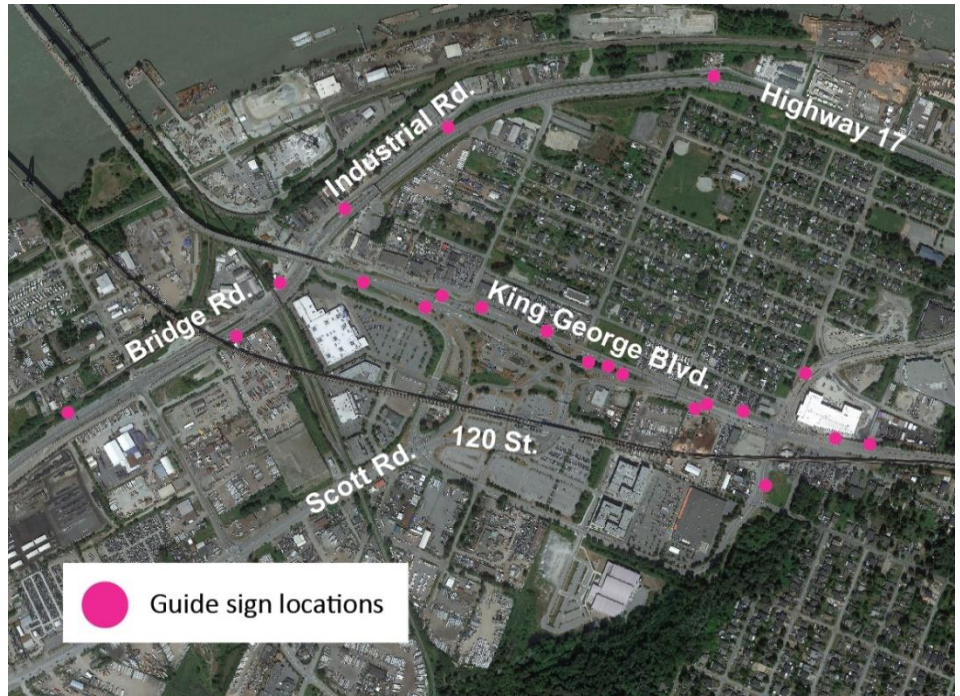

Starting Monday, September 29, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin building the foundations for 21 new overhead and roadside signs at various locations in Surrey. These signs will help direct drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians to the new bridge.

Building the foundations for each sign will take two to three days to complete. Work will be done 24 hours a day and will involve noisy activities such as hydrovaccing, which will be completed as early in the evenings as possible.

While this work is underway, the following closures will be implemented:

- Lane closures and overnight directional closures of Highway 17 (eastbound or westbound)
- Overnight southbound closures of the Pattullo Bridge
- Lane closures on King George Boulevard, 128 Street/Bridgeview Drive, and Industrial Road
- Overnight directional closures of 120 Street/Scott Road



Additional notification for the Highway 17 and Pattullo Bridge directional closures will be provided in advance and communicated via traffic media and posted on [drivebc.ca](https://drivebc.ca). Please also watch for signage indicating when closures and detours will be in place.

When overnight southbound closures of the Pattullo bridge are in effect, Pattullo Bridge users going to Surrey are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges.

When overnight directional closures of Highway 17 are in effect, drivers will be detoured between Bridgeview Drive and Tannery Road (as shown on the following page). Access for emergency responders and cyclists will not be maintained.

## What to Expect



### Timing

Starting Monday, September 29 and continuing for approximately two months.



### Hours of Work

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day. Noisy activities will be completed as early in the evenings as possible. When required, directional closures of Highway 17, the Pattullo Bridge (southbound) will be implemented between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Timing and durations of these overnight closures will be indicated on road signage and communicated in advance.



### Traffic

Temporary lane closures will be required on King George Boulevard, 128 Street/ Bridgeview Drive, Industrial Drive, and Highway 17. Occasional overnight directional closures will also be required on Highway 17, the Pattullo Bridge (southbound) and 120 Street/Scott Road. Traffic control personnel will be on-site as required.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents and businesses may hear noise from construction activities. Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to occasional detours.
