





Nighttime closures on Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard for milling and paving

September 5, 2025

Starting Sunday, September 7, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting milling and paving activities on Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard north of Royal Avenue. This work is weather dependent and will take approximately one to two weeks to complete.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists when necessary, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.

While this work is underway, the following traffic pattern changes will be in effect.

Traffic Pattern Change	Hours of Work	Approximate Duration
Overnight closures of Royal Avenue westbound between McBride Boulevard and 1 st Street	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	
Nighttime short-term closures of the Royal Avenue on-ramp – drivers will be detoured to the Columbia Street loop-ramp for access to the Pattullo Bridge	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	2 to 4 nights
Overnight closures of the off-ramp to Royal Avenue westbound from Bridge Connector southbound – drivers will be detoured at 6 th Avenue	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	
Overnight closures of McBride Boulevard north of Royal Avenue – temporary no parking will be in effect while these closures are in place	5 p.m. – 5 a.m.	2 to 4 nights

Access to Royal Avenue eastbound and McBride Boulevard southbound from the Royal Avenue loop-ramp will be maintained at all times.















What to Expect



Timing

Starting Sunday, September 7 for approximately one to two weeks.

This work is weather dependent.

Milling activities will be completed as early in the evening as possible.



Traffic

Nighttime closures of Royal Avenue westbound and McBride Boulevard north of Royal Avenue will be required.

Access to Royal Avenue westbound via the loop-ramp and southbound off-ramp from Bridge Connector will also be restricted, and occasional nighttime short-term closures of the Royal Avenue on-ramp will be required.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists when necessary. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with the milling and paving activities. Drivers may experience temporary delays resulting from required detours.
