





# Nighttime closures of the Highway 17 westbound off-ramp to Tannery Road

# October 14, 2025

Starting Tuesday, October 14, for approximately one week, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting electrical work across the Highway 17 westbound off-ramp to Tannery Road.

While this work is underway, a nighttime closure of the off-ramp will be required from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Drivers heading westbound on Highway 17 who want to access Tannery Road will be detoured at Bridgeview Drive to King George Boulevard and 120 Street (as shown below).

Signage will be in place and detour routes will be clearly marked. Access for emergency responders and cyclists will not be maintained while the closure is in place. Additional nighttime closures will be required to complete this work and will be communicated in advance.

#### **Timing**

Starting Tuesday, October 14 for approximately one week.

9 p.m. – 5 a.m.



#### Traffic

Westbound drivers on Highway 17 will be detoured at Bridgeview Drive to King George Boulevard and 120 Street for access to Tannery Road. All traffic pattern changes, and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers and cyclists may experience longer than normal travel times due to the detour. This work is not anticipated to be noisy.
