





Overnight closure of the Royal Avenue on-ramp

October 10, 2025

On Friday, October 10, the Royal Avenue on-ramp will be closed from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. This closure is required while Fraser Crossing Partners brings equipment onsite to install a new overhead sign near the entrance to the on-ramp.

As shown in the graphic on the right, drivers will be directed to use the Columbia Street loop ramp via McBride Boulevard to access the Pattullo Bridge. Detour signage will be in place.

The on-ramp closure is scheduled at night to minimize traffic impacts. This work is not anticipated to be noisy.
