Overnight closure of the Royal Avenue on-ramp

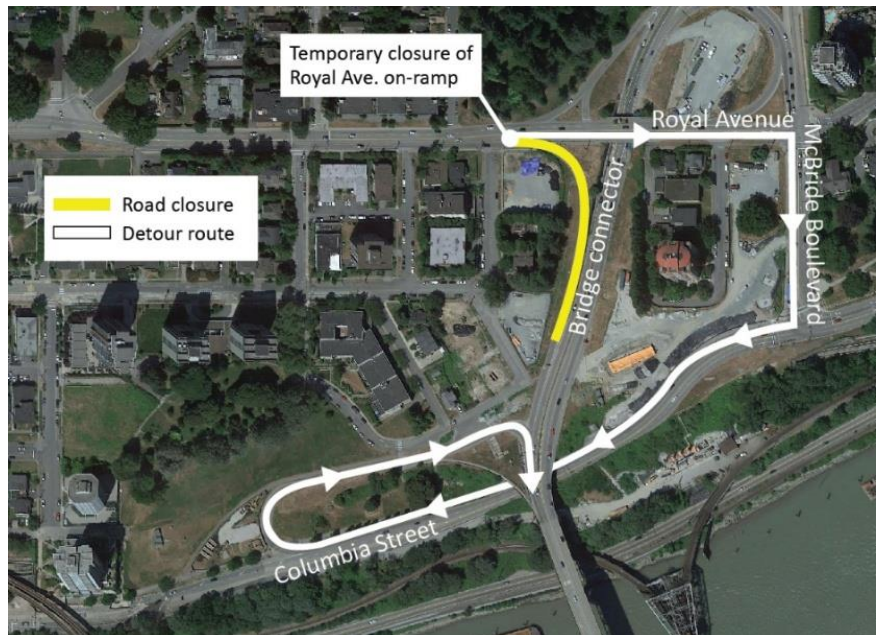
October 6, 2025

On Wednesday, October 8, the Royal Avenue on-ramp will be closed from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. This closure is required while Fraser Crossing Partners mobilizes equipment to install a new overhead sign near the entrance to the on-ramp.

As shown in the graphic on the right, drivers will be directed to use the Columbia Street loop-ramp via McBride Boulevard to access the Pattullo Bridge. Detour signage will be in place.

The on-ramp closure is scheduled at night to minimize traffic impacts. This work is not anticipated to be noisy.

Traffic will be directed to the Columbia Street loop-ramp to access the Pattullo Bridge. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.

Drivers may experience temporary delays resulting from the detour. This work is not anticipated to be noisy.
