






Overnight foundation construction for new overhead sign at Royal Avenue and Dufferin Street

October 9, 2025

On Thursday, October 9, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting overnight drilled shaft activities for the foundation of a new overhead guide sign at Royal Avenue and Dufferin Street. This sign will help direct drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians to the new bridge.

This work will take place between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. and will require some hydrovaccing activities that will be completed as early in the evening as possible.

On Friday, October 10, crews will conduct the concrete pour to complete the foundation. Crews will remove the drilled shaft equipment from site on Friday, October 10 or Tuesday, October 14, during which a closure of the Royal Avenue on-ramp may be required. If required, drivers will be directed to use the Columbia Street loop-ramp via McBrido Boulevard to access the Pattullo Bridge.

What to Expect



Timing

Thursday, October 9 (foundation construction), Friday, October 10 and/or Tuesday, October 14 (concrete pour and equipment removal).



Hours of Work

8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

A closure of the Royal Avenue on-ramp may be required on Friday, October 10 or Tuesday, October 14 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

If required, traffic will be directed to the Columbia Street loop-ramp to access the Pattullo Bridge. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from the foundation construction activities.
