





# Overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street

## October 9, 2025

Starting Tuesday, October 14, Fraser Crossing Partners will be installing the final girders for the new E. Columbia exitramp. This work will take approximately two weeks to complete. While most work will be completed with single lane closures, overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street will be required on the nights of Tuesday, October 14, Wednesday, October 15, and Friday, October 17.

Follow-up notifications will be provided if additional overnight local closures are required.

While the overnight local closures are in place, drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. The Columbia Street loop-ramp will be closed, and access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via McBride Boulevard (Bridge Connector) and the Royal Avenue on-ramp. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists.

Columbia Street between 6th Street and Elliot Street will remain open for local traffic **and access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times**. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed.

## What to Expect



#### **Timing**

Starting Tuesday, October 14 and continuing for approximately two weeks. Overnight local closures of Columbia Street will be required on October 14, 15, and 17. Follow-up notifications will be provided if additional overnight local closures are required.



#### **Hours of Work**

Overnight closures will be in effect from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

General work activities will take place 24 hours a day.



#### Traffic

Drivers will be detoured to Royal or Front.
Columbia between 6th Street and Elliot will remain open for local traffic only. Access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via the Bridge Connector and Royal on-ramp. Drivers travelling westbound on E. Columbia Street will be detoured at Braid to access the Pattullo Bridge. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to designated truck routes at all times. All traffic pattern changes, and detour routes will be well signed.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours and stoppages. Nearby residents may hear some noise while the girder installation activities are underway.
