





Overnight foundation construction for new overhead sign at Royal Avenue and 2nd Street

October 16, 2025

On Friday, October 17, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting overnight drilled shaft activities for the foundation of a new overhead guide sign at Royal Avenue and 2nd Street. This sign will help direct drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians to the new bridge.

This work will take place between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. and will require some hydrovaccing activities that will be completed as early in the evening as possible. One lane in each direction will be maintained on Royal Avenue with a left-turn restriction from eastbound Royal Avenue to northbound 2nd Street and a left-turn restriction from southbound 2nd Street to eastbound Royal Avenue.

On Monday, October 20, crews will conduct the concrete pour to complete the foundation. Crews plan to remove the drilled shaft equipment from site on Tuesday, October 21.

What to Expect



Timing

Friday, October 17 (foundation construction), Monday, October 20 (concrete pour) and Tuesday, October 21 (equipment removal). This work is weather dependent.



Hours of Work

8 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

One lane in each direction maintained on Royal with a left-turn restriction from eastbound Royal to northbound 2nd Street and a left-turn restriction from southbound 2nd Street to eastbound Royal. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from the foundation construction activities.
