





Nighttime bolting for the new E. Columbia exit-ramp

On Tuesday, October 14, Fraser Crossing Partners began installing the final girders for the new E. Columbia exit-ramp. Occasional overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street were required; however, the remaining work will be completed with single lane closures.

As the girders are installed, crews need to install steel bolts to ensure the girders are safely secured. This is a critical piece of work that needs to be completed prior to crews installing the deck panels and pouring the concrete to complete the structure. This structure will provide a new connection for northbound traffic from the new bridge to E. Columbia Street.

Single lane closures on Columbia Street are required. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.
