





Overnight foundation construction for new overhead sign at Royal Avenue and 2nd Street

UPDATED: October 20, 2025

On Friday, October 17, Fraser Crossing Partners began conducting overnight drilled shaft activities for the foundation of a new overhead guide sign at Royal Avenue and 2nd Street. This sign will help direct drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians to the new bridge.

This work will take place between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. and will require some hydrovaccing activities that will be completed as early in the evening as possible. One lane in each direction will be maintained on Royal Avenue with a left-turn restriction from eastbound Royal Avenue to northbound 2nd Street and a left-turn restriction from southbound 2nd Street to eastbound Royal Avenue.

On Monday, October 20, crews will conduct additional drilling activities. On Tuesday, October 21, crews will conduct the concrete pour to complete the foundation. Crews plan to remove the drilled shaft equipment from site on Wednesday, October 22. This will complete the work at this location until the overhead sign is installed in December.

What to Expect



Timing

Monday, October 20 (foundation construction), Tuesday, October 21 (concrete pour) and Wednesday, October 22 (equipment removal). This work is weather dependent.



Hours of Work

8 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

One lane in each direction maintained on Royal with a left-turn restriction from eastbound Royal to northbound 2nd Street and a left-turn restriction from southbound 2nd Street to eastbound Royal. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from the foundation construction activities.
