






# Mitigations to reduce traffic congestion in Victoria Hill neighbourhood

# Columbia Street / Columbia loop-ramp closures

After traffic has been shifted onto the new bridge, Pattullo Bridge removal activities will begin.

A local closure of Columbia St between McBride Blvd and Elliot St, for approximately one month, will be required to deconstruct the Pattullo Bridge and start construction of the new Columbia loop-ramp. Following the re-opening of Columbia St, the existing Columbia loop-ramp will remain closed for crews to finish building the new loop-ramp.



#### Implementation of mitigations to help prevent traffic short-cutting through Victoria Hill

- **Detour signage at Braid and Cumberland** to direct westbound vehicles on E. Columbia to E. 8<sup>th</sup> Street for access to the new bridge.
- Left-turn restriction from Memorial to McBride between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.
- "No U-turns" signage at Memorial to prevent northbound vehicles on McBride from entering Memorial and attempting a U-turn within Victoria Hill to access the bridge.
- "No trucks" and "local traffic only" signage at the East Royal and McBride intersection.


### Additional mitigation option if required: closure of eastbound access to Victoria Hill from Royal and McBride

The Project team will consider this option if traffic congestion remains an issue within Victoria Hill.

In this scenario:

- Residents, businesses, workers, and delivery trucks will access Victoria Hill via Memorial. The left-turn restriction from Memorial will no longer be required.
- Westbound access out of Victoria Hill will be maintained via East Royal to McBride and Royal.
- Access for emergency vehicles in and out of Victoria Hill via East Royal will be maintained at all times.

Prior to this mitigation measure being implemented, the Project team would engage with Victoria Hill residents, businesses, and healthcare facilities.
