



Pattullo Bridge: Overnight northbound closure for nighttime milling and paving on Bridge Connector and off-ramps

UPDATED: October 28, 2025

Starting Wednesday, October 29, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting milling and paving activities on the bridge approach in New Westminster (Bridge Connector), the southbound off-ramp to Royal Avenue, and the northbound loop-ramp to Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard. This work was originally scheduled to begin Tuesday, October 28 but was rescheduled due to weather. This work will take approximately four nights to complete and is weather dependent. To complete this work, the following traffic pattern changes will be required:

Date	Time	Traffic pattern changes
Wednesday, October 29	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Bridge Connector reduced to one-lane in each direction; closure of the northbound loop-ramp to Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard
Thursday, October 30	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Closure of both northbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge (towards New Westminster)
Friday, October 31	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Bridge Connector reduced to one-lane in each direction; closure of the southbound off-ramp to Royal Avenue
Saturday, November 1	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Bridge Connector reduced to one-lane in each direction

Pattullo Bridge users going to New Westminster during the overnight closure on Thursday, October 30 are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges. Southbound travel will remain open but will be reduced to one lane, per TransLink's recurring overnight lane closure for drivers travelling from New Westminster to Surrey. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected users should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained.

Timing

Starting Wednesday, October 29 for approximately four nights. This work is weather dependent.



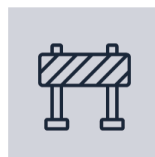
Hours of Work

Traffic

Overnight closures of the southbound off-ramp to Royal Avenue, the Royal Avenue loop-ramp, and the northbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge will be required. Detours will be required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers and transit users may experience longer than normal travel times due to the northbound lane closures. Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with the overnight milling and paving activities.
