





Overnight closures of King George Boulevard eastbound between 124 Street and 126a Street

October 31, 2025

Starting Sunday, November 2, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting foundation work for a new overhead sign on King George Boulevard.

Due to the positioning of equipment, King George Boulevard will be closed in the eastbound direction between 124 Street and 126a Street from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for approximately five nights.

While this work is underway, eastbound drivers will be detoured to the Scott Road exit-ramps to reconnect with King George Boulevard (as shown in the graphic on the right).

Traffic

King George Boulevard eastbound will be closed between 124 Street and 126a Street. Drivers will take a slight detour via the Scott Road exit-ramps. All traffic pattern changes and the detour route will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents and businesses may hear noise from construction activities. Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to the required detours.
