





Weekend closure of Highway 17 eastbound between Tannery Road and Bridgeview Drive

November 4, 2025

Please be advised that from 9 p.m. on Friday, November 7 to 5 a.m. on Monday, November 10, Highway 17 eastbound will be closed between Tannery Road and Bridgeview Drive for crews to install new light bases along the centre median. The Highway 17 westbound fast lane will also be closed; the westbound slow lane will remain open.

While these closures are in place, eastbound drivers will be detoured at Tannery Road to travel on 120 Street, King George Boulevard, and Bridgeview Drive to reconnect with Highway 17.

Access for emergency responders and cyclists will not be maintained. Detour routes will be clearly marked and are shown below:

Highway 17 eastbound drivers will be detoured at Tannery Road to travel on 120 Street, King George Boulevard, then Bridgeview Drive to reconnect with Highway 17. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.
