





# Overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride **Boulevard and Elliot Street**

# November 6, 2025

Starting Wednesday, November 12, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin removing formwork and installing drainage on the new bridge deck across Columbia Street. This work will take approximately four nights to complete and will require overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street.

Drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. The Columbia Street loop-ramp will be closed, and access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via McBride Boulevard (Bridge Connector) and the Royal Avenue on-ramp. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists; however, short stoppages of up to 10 minutes may be required.

Columbia Street between 6th Street and Elliot Street will remain open for local traffic and access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed.



Additional closures on Columbia Street and Front Street will be required to complete the remaining bridge deck construction activities. Follow-up notifications will be provided. Front Street and Columbia Street will not be fully closed at the same time.

# What to Expect



#### **Timing**

Starting Wednesday, November 12 for approximately four nights.



## **Hours of Work**

9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



#### Traffic

Drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. Columbia Street between 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Elliot Street will remain open for local traffic only. Access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via the Bridge Connector and Royal Avenue on-ramp. Drivers travelling westbound on E. Columbia Street will be detoured at Braid Street to access the Pattullo Bridge. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to designated truck routes at all times. All traffic pattern changes, and detour routes will be well signed.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours and stoppages. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with the formwork removal activities.
