





# Pattullo Bridge: Overnight southbound closures

# November 24, 2025

Starting Thursday, November 27, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting foundation work for a new overhead guide sign along King George Boulevard where the bridge connects in Surrey. This work will take approximately three nights to complete. To complete this work, both southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge will be closed on the evenings noted in the table below:

| Thursday, November 27 | 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. | Closure of both southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge (towards Surrey); closure of the southbound off-ramp to Royal Avenue |

Pattullo Bridge users going to Surrey during these overnight closures are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges. Northbound travel will remain open but will be reduced to one lane, per TransLink's recurring overnight lane closure for drivers travelling from Surrey to New Westminster. Southbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected users should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Confirmation of closures will be communicated in advance via traffic media and posted on <a href="mailto:drivebc.ca">drivebc.ca</a>. Please watch for signage indicating when closures and detours will be in place. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will not be maintained.

## What to Expect



#### **Timing**

The evenings of Thursday, November 27, Friday, November 28 and Sunday, November 30.



#### **Hours of Work**

9 p.m. - 5 a.m.



#### Traffic

Overnight closures of the southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge. Detours will be required; southbound drivers are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser Bridges.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Access for pedestrians and cyclists will not be maintained. Drivers and transit users may experience longer than normal travel times due to the southbound lane closures. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with the overnight activities.
