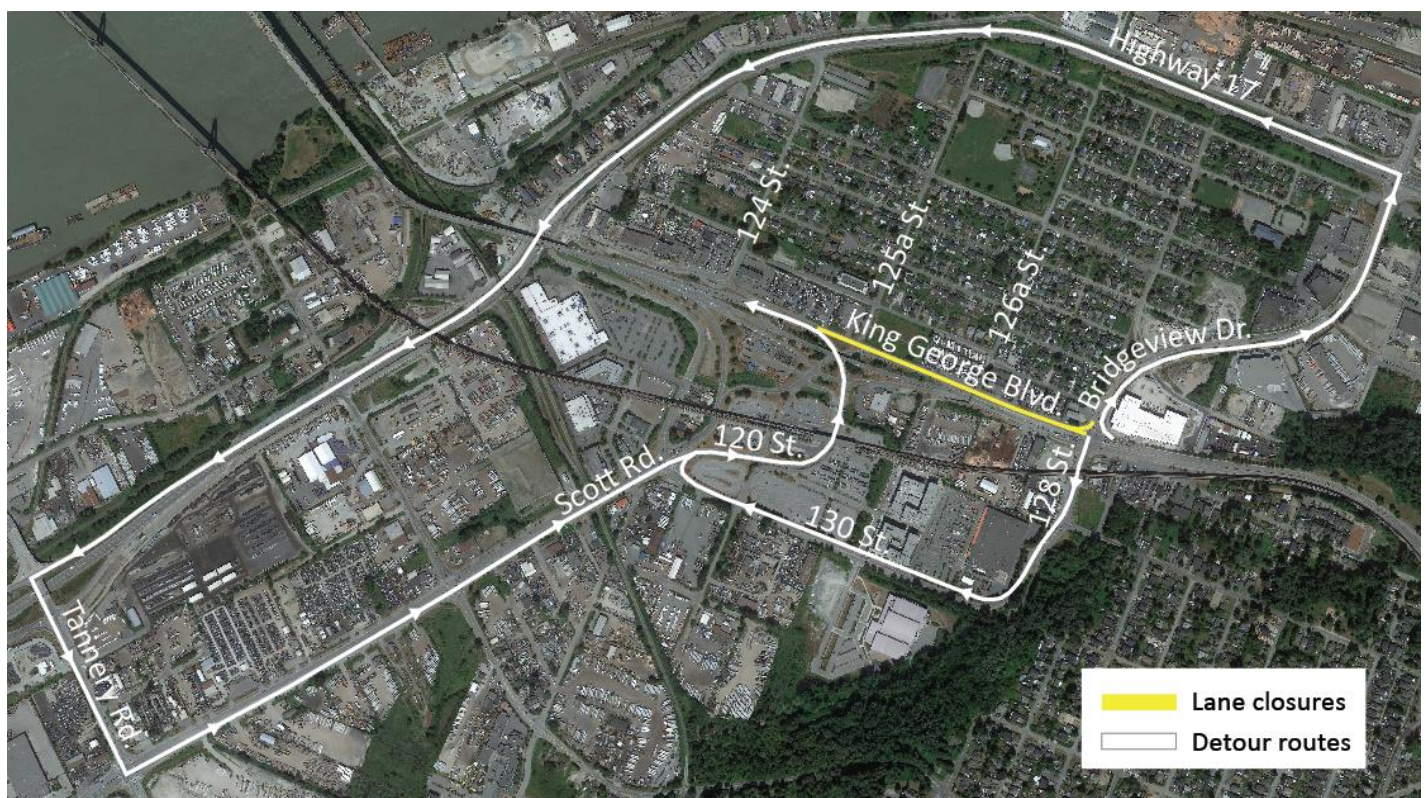
Overnight closures of King George Boulevard westbound/northbound between Bridgeview Drive and 125a St.

December 11, 2025

Starting Thursday, December 11, Fraser Crossing Partners will be installing the structure for a new overhead sign on King George Boulevard. Due to the positioning of equipment, King George Boulevard will be closed in the westbound/northbound direction between Bridgeview Drive and 125a Street from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for approximately four nights.

While this work is underway, drivers will be detoured to the 120 Street/Scott Road on-ramp via 128 and 130 Street to reconnect with King George Boulevard (as shown in the graphic on the right). Trucks will be detoured to the 120 Street/Scott Road on-ramp via Highway 17 westbound and Tannery Road. Access to the Pattullo Bridge and 124 Street will be maintained.

Timing

Starting Thursday, December 11 for approximately four nights.



Hours of Work

9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

King George Boulevard westbound/northbound will be closed between Bridgeview Drive and 125a Street. Drivers will be detoured to the 120 Street/Scott Road on-ramp via 128 and 130 Street to reconnect with King George Boulevard. Trucks will be detoured to the 120 Street/Scott Road on-ramp via Highway 17 westbound and Tannery Road. Access All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents and businesses may hear noise from construction activities. Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to the required detour.
