



Pattullo Bridge: Overnight southbound closure

UPDATED: December 1, 2025

Foundation work for a new overhead guide sign along King George Boulevard, where the bridge connects in Surrey, remains underway. To complete this work, an additional overnight closure of both southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge will be required on Monday, December 1, as noted in the table below:

Date	Time	Traffic pattern changes
Thursday, November 27 – complete	9 p.m. – 2 a.m.	Closure of both southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge (towards Surrey) ; closure of the southbound off-ramp to Royal Avenue
Friday, November 28 – complete		
Sunday, November 30 – complete		
Monday, December 1		

Pattullo Bridge users going to Surrey during this overnight closure are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges. Northbound travel will remain open but will be reduced to one lane, per TransLink's recurring overnight lane closure for drivers travelling from Surrey to New Westminster. Southbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected users should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Confirmation of closures will be communicated in advance via traffic media and posted on drivebc.ca. Please watch for signage indicating when closures and detours will be in place. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will not be maintained.

An additional closure is required on the evening of Monday, December 1.



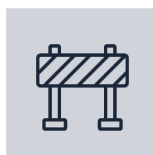
Hours of Work

Traffic

An overnight closure of the southbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge. Detours will be required; southbound drivers are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser Bridges.



Impacts/Interruptions

Access for pedestrians and cyclists will not be maintained. Drivers and transit users may experience longer than normal travel times due to the southbound lane closures. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with the overnight activities.
