





# Overnight closures of Front Street

# UPDATED: December 5, 2025

Overnight closures of Front Street remain ongoing for Fraser Crossing Partners to install drainage and fencing on the new bridge deck. The overnight closures will continue the week of December 8 and must be completed while there is no traffic underneath to ensure public safety.

Front Street Mews will remain open and access to businesses in downtown New Westminster will be maintained at all times. While Front Street is closed, trucks will be required to use official truck routes (which exclude Columbia Street at all hours, and Royal Avenue after 9 p.m.) and regular traffic will be detoured to Columbia Street. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.

#### Traffic

While Front Street is closed, regular traffic will be detoured to Columbia Street. Trucks will be detoured to <u>designated truck routes</u> at all times. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with the drainage and fencing installation activities.
