




Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project

Construction activities after stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge opening in New Westminster

The new Columbia Street loop-ramp will open after the stal'əwasəm Bridge opens with all four lanes, as it cannot be completed until sections of the connecting roadways and the Pattullo Bridge have been removed.



After the new bridge is open, additional construction work includes:



Key traffic changes

Some road closures will be required for construction to complete the ramps and multi-use paths. Some sidewalk and multi-use path closures and detours will also be required. Major road closures will be sequential, and Front and Columbia Streets will not be closed at the same time. **Access to downtown New Westminster businesses will be maintained.**

- Starting in late February/early March: A **local closure of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street**, for approximately four to six weeks, will be required for crews to deconstruct the Pattullo Bridge, build the multi-use path over Columbia, and start building the new Columbia loop-ramp.
- After Columbia Street is open, a **closure of Front Street** is required for approximately six months starting in spring 2026 for bridge deconstruction over Front Street and the railway lines.
- In summer 2026, the new Columbia loop-ramp will re-open.

More information on timing and duration for road closures will be provided as planning progresses.

Landscaping

Tree planting and landscaping works will begin in fall 2026 after roads and multi-use paths are complete.
