



Closure of the Pattullo Bridge and stal'əwəsəm (Riverview) Bridge

February 2, 2026

Starting at 8 p.m. on February 6, the Pattullo Bridge and stal'əwəsəm (Riverview) Bridge will be closed in both directions for approximately one week for crews to complete the connections to the roadways on either side. This includes major roadworks to build the road connections including raising the ground elevation with fill, installing utilities, and completing paving, as well as installing the foundation for the Royal-Agnes multi-use path overpass.

Pattullo Bridge users are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the closure. Northbound and southbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained on the sidewalk of the Pattullo Bridge. Access to businesses along King George Boulevard in Surrey and businesses in downtown New Westminster will be maintained at all times.

Once this work is complete, two northbound lanes and one southbound lane will be open on the stal'əwəsəm Bridge. One southbound lane will remain open on the Pattullo Bridge. Drivers will be directed as follows:

| Direction of travel | Bridge to use |
|--|--|
| Northbound into New Westminster | Drivers will use stal'əwəsəm Bridge. |
| Southbound into Surrey from McBride Boulevard (Bridge Connector) | Drivers will use stal'əwəsəm Bridge (no direct access to Scott Road, follow detour). |
| Southbound into Surrey from Royal Avenue eastbound | Drivers will be detoured onto the Pattullo Bridge via the Columbia Street loop-ramp. |
| Southbound into Surrey from E. Columbia Street westbound | Drivers will use the Pattullo Bridge via the Columbia Street loop-ramp. |
| Pedestrians and cyclists in both directions | Use Pattullo Bridge sidewalk. |




New Westminster: New Bridge Open

Timing

Starting at 8 p.m. on February 6 for approximately one week. Exact dates are weather dependent.



Hours of Work

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Full closure of Pattullo and stal'əwəsəm bridges. Pedestrian and cyclist access maintained on Pattullo Bridge sidewalk.



Impacts/Interruptions

Pattullo Bridge users may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours. Nearby residents may hear noise associated with ongoing construction activities.
