



Regular Traffic Detour (*non-commercial vehicles*)

Columbia Street closure / Columbia loop-ramp closure

The Columbia Street loop-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge is closed and the new Columbia Street on-ramp to the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge is planned to open in summer 2026.

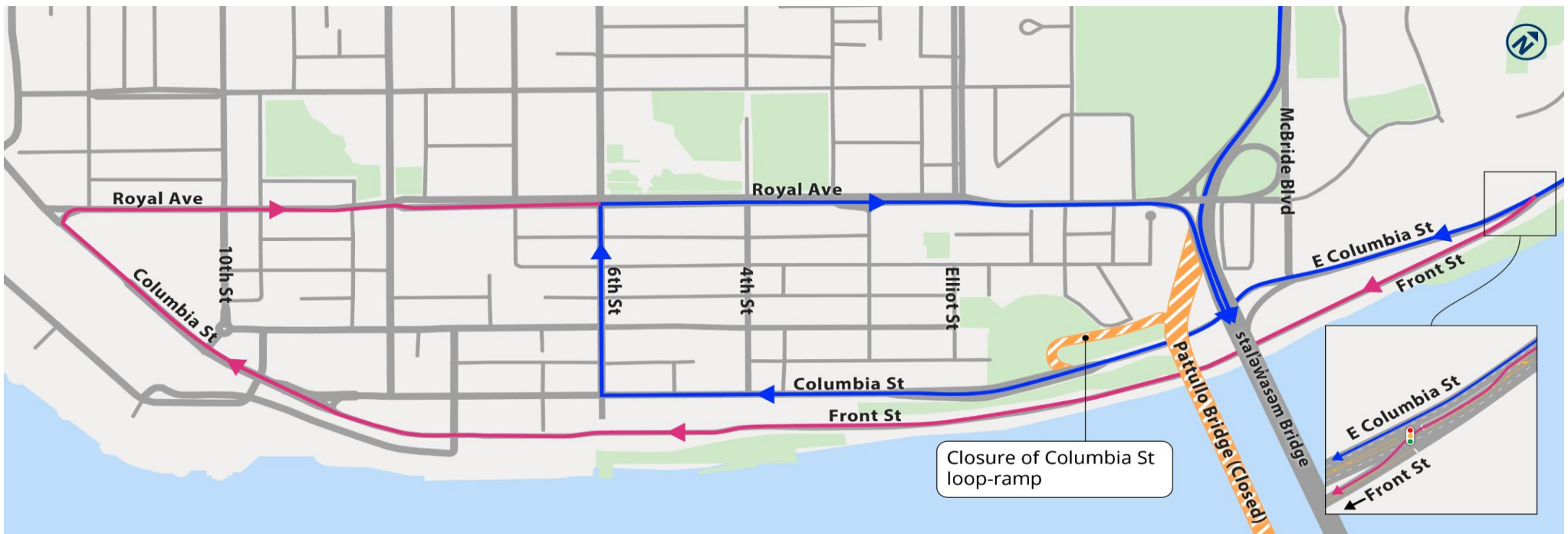
A local closure of Columbia Street between McBride and Elliot Street is required for approximately 4 to 6 weeks starting in late February, for Project construction and deconstruction activities.




While these closures are in effect, drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue and Front Street as shown below. Access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via McBride Boulevard and the Royal Avenue on-ramp until the new Columbia Street on-ramp is open. Columbia Street west of Elliot Street will remain open. **Access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times via 4th Street and 6th Street.** Commercial vehicles will continue to use Front Street and official truck routes.

All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed.

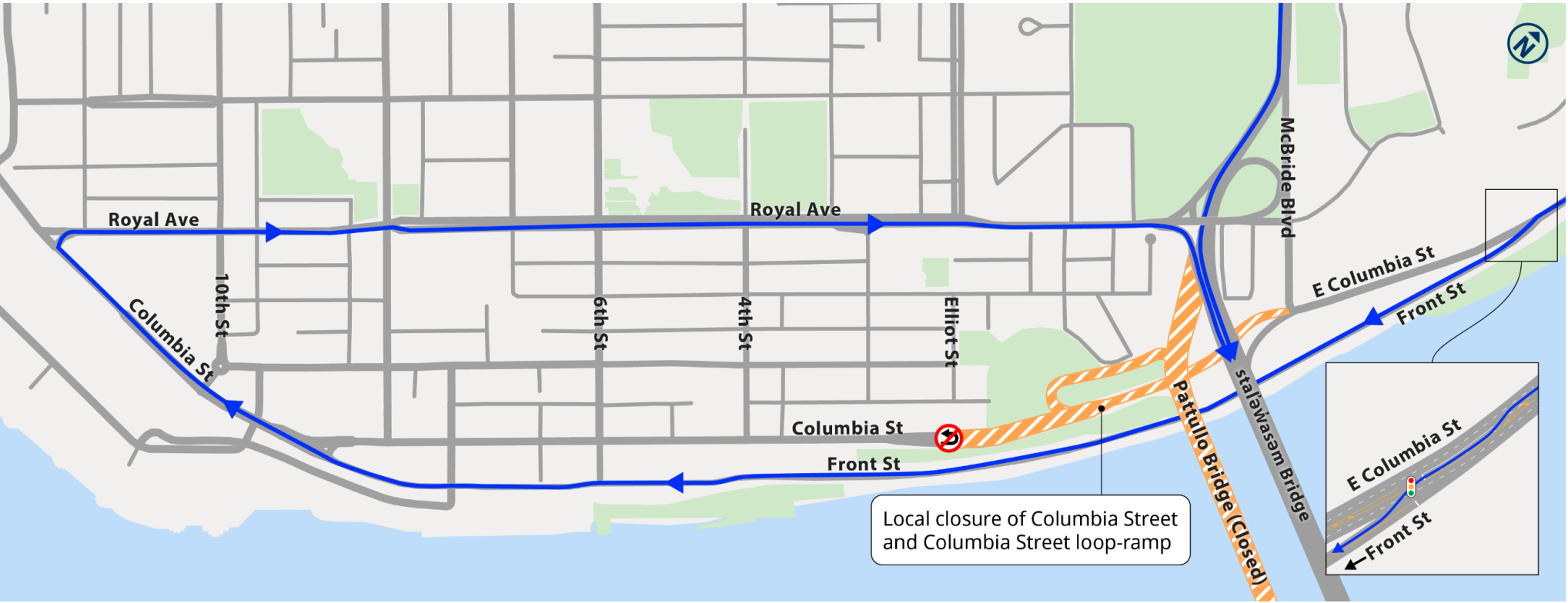
