



Surrey construction activities during one-week closure of Pattullo and stal'ə́wasəm bridges

February 4, 2026

Starting at 8 p.m. on Friday, February 6, the Pattullo Bridge and stal'ə́wasəm (Riverview) Bridge will be closed in both directions for approximately one week for crews to complete the connections to roadways on either side. While this closure is in place, access to businesses along King George Boulevard and 112 Avenue in Surrey will be maintained. **There will be no change to the current driveway access.**

Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise as crews complete major roadworks. Construction activities include saw cutting, asphalt removal, embankment fill, base work, paving, line painting, and barricades and sign placing.

To reduce the amount of time both bridges are closed, work activities will take place 24 hours a day. While crews will try to complete noisy activities during the day, some of these activities will be completed at night, leading to nighttime noise.

Timing

Starting at 8 p.m. on Friday, February 6 for approximately one week. Exact dates are weather dependent.



Hours of Work

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Full closure of Pattullo and stal'ə́wasəm bridges. Pedestrian and cyclist access maintained on Pattullo Bridge sidewalk.



Impacts/Interruptions

Noise associated with construction activities including saw-cutting, asphalt removal, milling and construction equipment.
