
Columbia Street closure / Columbia loop-ramp closure

The Columbia Street loop-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge is closed and the new Columbia Street on-ramp to the *stal'əwasəm* (Riverview) Bridge is planned to open in summer 2026.

A local closure of Columbia Street between McBride and Elliot Street is required for approximately 4 to 6 weeks starting in late February, for Project construction and deconstruction activities.

While these closures are in effect, commercial vehicles will continue to use Front Street and official 24/7 truck routes as shown below. Access to the *stal'əwasəm* Bridge will be maintained via McBride Boulevard (24/7) and the Royal Avenue on-ramp (daytime) until the new Columbia Street on-ramp is open. **Access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times via 4th Street and 6th Street.**

Westbound commercial vehicles travelling to Surrey after 9 p.m. are encouraged to use the Port Mann, Queensborough, and Alex Fraser bridges. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed.
