




Four lanes opening on stal'ə́wəsəm (Riverview) Bridge and permanent closure of the Pattullo Bridge

February 13, 2026

At approximately 7 a.m. on Saturday, February 14, all four lanes will open on the stal'ə́wəsəm Bridge, and the Pattullo Bridge will permanently close for deconstruction. Access to the stal'ə́wəsəm Bridge will be available via McBride Boulevard and the new Royal Avenue on-ramp in New Westminster, and King George Boulevard in Surrey.

Work will continue on the multi-use path connections to the bridge. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will not be available on the bridge until the multi-use path on the east side of the stal'ə́wəsəm Bridge opens this spring. 

PATTULLO BRIDGE
REPLACEMENT



Removal of the Pattullo Bridge is scheduled to begin in late February. Crews will mobilize equipment, establish safe work zones, and conduct preparation activities in advance of concrete and steel removal.

Crews will begin by removing a section of the Pattullo Bridge over Columbia Street and starting construction of the new Columbia on-ramp and E. Columbia multi-use path overpass. The new Columbia Street on-ramp to the stäl'əwasəm Bridge is planned to open in summer 2026.

This work requires the following traffic changes:

1. Closure of the existing Columbia Street loop-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge – starting Saturday, February 14
 - Access to the stäl'əwasəm Bridge will be maintained via McBride Boulevard (Bridge Connector) and Royal Avenue on-ramp.

2. A local closure of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street for approximately four to six weeks – starting February 26
 - Drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. Columbia Street between 6th and Elliot will remain open for local traffic and **access to all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times.**
 - Drivers wishing to access the stal'əwəsəm Bridge from East Columbia can use Front Street.

Timing

Starting at approximately 7 a.m. on Saturday, February 14.



Hours of Work

Deconstruction activities will continue 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Four lanes of traffic on the stal'əwəsəm Bridge from McBride Boulevard and the new Royal Avenue on-ramp in New Westminster, and King George Boulevard in Surrey. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.
