



Intermittent access restrictions to Bushby Street from Royal Avenue

February 20, 2026

Fraser Crossing Partners is building a new retaining wall alongside Bridge Connector and Bushby Street south of Royal Avenue.

Starting Friday, February 20 over the next two months, access in and out of Bushby Street from Royal Avenue will be intermittently restricted to support retaining wall construction. To access Bushby Street, local residents will be directed to Leopold Place where access in and out will be maintained. Temporary no parking will be in effect on the west side of Bushby Street.

Access to the existing sidewalk on the south side of Royal Avenue will be maintained while restrictions are in place.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting Friday, February 20 intermittently over the next two months.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Access and parking restrictions to and from Bushby Street may be in place 24 hours a day when needed.



Traffic

Local traffic will be directed to Leopold Place to access Bushby Street during the access restrictions to Bushby Street at Royal Avenue. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from construction activities. Temporary no parking will be in effect on the west side of Bushby Street.
