

Overnight closures of Royal Avenue off-ramp

February 20, 2026

On the nights of Monday, February 23, and Tuesday, February 24, Fraser Crossing Partners will install structures for the new overhead signs on the Royal Avenue off-ramp.

To complete this work, overnight closures of the Royal Avenue off-ramp will be required from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Drivers travelling from the stal'əwasəm Bridge northbound to East Columbia Street can use the new East Columbia off-ramp. Drivers travelling to Royal Avenue will be detoured to McBride Boulevard and 8th Avenue (see graphic on the right).

While this closure is in effect, access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained on the Royal Avenue off-ramp.
