



Daytime off-peak lane closures on the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge

March 4, 2026

Starting on Monday March 9, lane closures will be in effect during the daytime off-peak period on the stal'əwasəm Bridge for approximately 4 – 6 weeks. These lane closures are required to complete the multi-use paths and other finishing activities.

One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting on Monday, March 9, for approximately 4 – 6 weeks. Exact dates are weather dependent.



Hours of Work

9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (weekdays southbound)
10 a.m. to 3 p.m. (weekdays northbound)
7 a.m. to 2 p.m. (Saturdays)



Traffic

Daytime off-peak lane closures will be in effect on the stal'əwasəm Bridge. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will be on site, and advanced signage will be in place.



Impacts/Interruptions

stal'əwasəm Bridge users may experience minor delays. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.
