



# Closures of 112/111a Avenue for deconstruction activities of the Pattullo Bridge

March 10, 2026

Starting at approximately 7 p.m. on Friday, March 13 until 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 16, a full closure of 112/111a Avenue under the Pattullo Bridge will be in place. The closure is required for Fraser Crossing Partners to remove a section of the Pattullo Bridge over 112/111a Avenue.

While this closure is in effect, drivers travelling west to 111a Avenue will be detoured to 112a Avenue, 128 Street, and 110 Avenue. Drivers travelling east to 112a Avenue will be detoured to 110 Avenue, and 128 Street (see map below for reference). Emergency responder access to 112/111a Avenue will not be maintained.

Nearby residents will hear noise associated with deconstruction activities. Deconstruction activities involve pavement removal on the south approach; removal of bridge girders above 112/111a Avenue; and removal of the concrete abutment and piers. Heavy equipment will be on site removing bridge components including concrete and loading up trucks.

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day. While crews will try to complete noisy activities during the day, some of these activities will be completed at night.

## What to Expect



### Timing

Starting at approximately 7 p.m. on Friday, March 13 until 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 16.



### Hours of Work

Work activities will take place 24 hours a day from approximately 7 p.m. on March 13 until 5 a.m. on March 16.



### Traffic

A full closure of 112/111a Avenue under the Pattullo Bridge. Drivers travelling west to 111a Avenue will be detoured to 112a Avenue, 128 Street, and 110 Avenue. Drivers travelling east to 112 Avenue will be detoured to 110 Avenue, and 128 Street. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours. Nearby residents will hear noise associated with deconstruction activities.
