



Daytime closure of Bridge Road for concrete pours on new Highway 17 off-ramp

March 26, 2026

Starting at 5 a.m. until approximately 2 p.m. on Friday, March 27, a closure of Bridge Road is required for crews to work on concrete deck pours on the new Highway 17 off-ramp.

While this closure is in effect, traffic will be detoured via 120 Street and Bridgeview Drive to access 116 Avenue, Industrial Road, and Musqueam Drive (see graphic on the right).



Access for emergency responders will not be maintained while this closure is in effect. Detour routes will be clearly marked. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers when required.

A weekend closure of Bridge Road will also be in effect starting Friday, March 27, at 7 p.m. until Monday, March 30 at 5 a.m for Pattullo Bridge deconstruction activities.

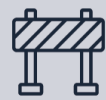
