



UPDATED: Overnight closures of East Columbia off-ramp on the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge

March 26, 2026

Starting at approximately 8 p.m. on Thursday, March 5, Fraser Crossing Partners began nightly closures of the East Columbia off-ramp from the stal'əwasəm Bridge to East Columbia Street for approximately four to six weeks. These closures will support the construction of the superstructure of the new East Columbia multi-use path overpass.

While these closures are in effect, drivers travelling northbound on the stal'əwasəm Bridge will be detoured to the Royal Avenue off-ramp on to McBride Boulevard to East Columbia Street (see map for reference).

Nearby residents will hear some noise associated with [construction activities](#). Emergency responder access to the East Columbia off-ramp will not be maintained.

All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.

Timing

Traffic

Drivers travelling northbound on the stal'əwəsəm Bridge can take the Royal Avenue off-ramp to McBride Boulevard southbound to East Columbia. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours. Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with construction activities.
