**PATTULLO BRIDGE
REPLACEMENT**



1. Pattullo Bridge Deconstruction

Pattullo Bridge deconstruction work is underway. Work is expected to be complete by the end of 2027, with some removal activities taking place concurrently. On the Surrey side, work is beginning with the removal of a section intersecting with the new Highway 17 off-ramp and over Highway 17, as well as preparation works in Brownsville Bar Park including the construction of a crane pad and temporary access road. Traffic closures will be required during demolition and are anticipated to take place for demolition of the Pattullo Bridge over Highway 17 over four consecutive weekends during the months of March – April 2026.

2. Construction of the New Highway 17 Off-ramp

The new off-ramp will connect southbound vehicles directly to Highway 17 westbound and will open to traffic in summer 2026.

3. Multi-Use Path Connections to stal'əwasəm Bridge

The multi-use path (MUP) on the east side of the stal'əwasəm Bridge will open in May 2026 for pedestrians and cyclists in both directions. The other MUP, on the west side of the stal'əwasəm Bridge, will open by summer 2026 at which point the MUPs will be directional for cyclists. To maintain cyclist access on the stal'əwasəm Bridge, a free shuttle is available to transport cyclists across the bridge during weekday morning and evening peak periods (6:30-9:30 a.m. and 3:30-6:30 p.m.) when bikes are not allowed on SkyTrain. 4. Roadwork to Upgrade Bridge Road to Two-way Traffic

Bridge Road is now temporarily re-opened to two-way traffic and westbound vehicles have a new connection from Industrial Road to Old Yale Road. Construction on the new Highway 17 off-ramp is ongoing, and to support this work, future closures of Bridge Road will be required.
