



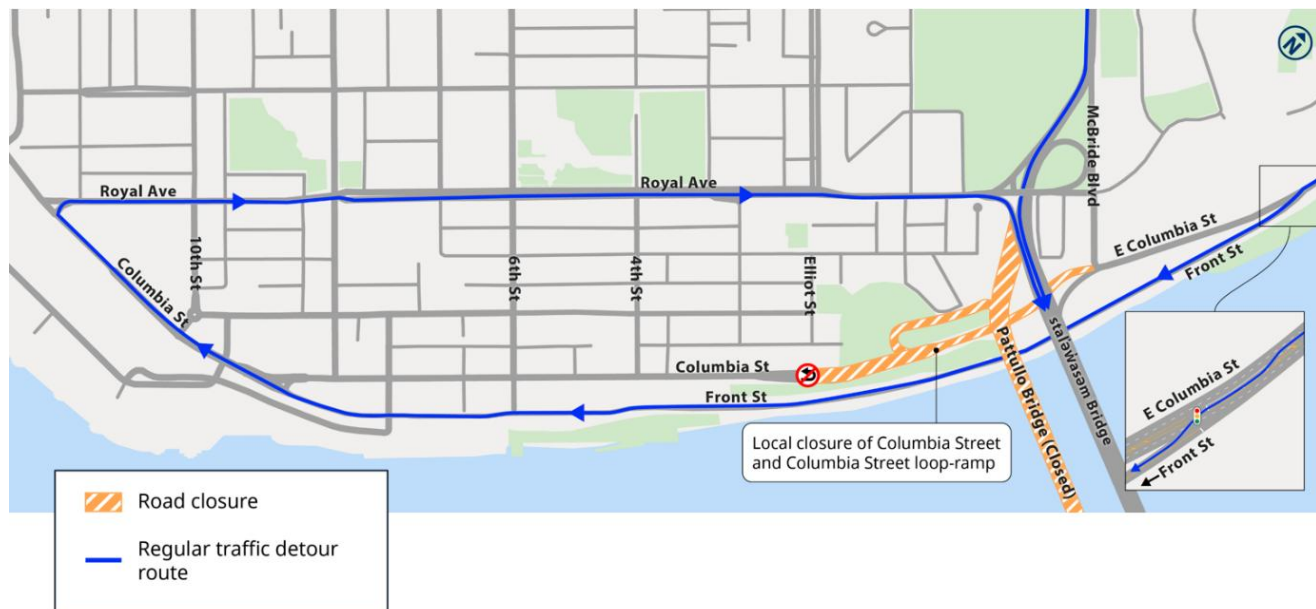
Overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street

Updated: April 17, 2026

Fraser Crossing Partners began overnight local closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street for approximately two weeks starting on Monday, April 13. These closures are required for work on the new Columbia Street multi-use path overpass over Columbia Street.

Drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. The new Columbia Street on-ramp is under construction, and access to the stal'awasəm (Riverview) Bridge continues to be maintained via McBride Boulevard and the Royal Avenue on-ramp.

Columbia Street west of Elliot Street will remain open and **access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times**. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed.



While these overnight closures are in effect, access for emergency responders will not be maintained. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to designated truck routes at all times.

Traffic

Drivers will be detoured to Royal Avenue or Front Street. Columbia Street west of Elliot Street will remain open. Commercial vehicles will be detoured to [designated truck routes](#) at all times. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required.
