



Mitigations to reduce traffic congestion in Victoria Hill

Columbia Street / Columbia loop-ramp closures

The Columbia Street loop-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge is closed and the new Columbia Street on-ramp to the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge is planned to open in summer 2026. Intermittent local closures of Columbia Street between McBride and Elliot Street are required for Project construction activities.

Mitigations to help prevent traffic short-cutting through Victoria Hill are in place.

- A 24/7 closure of eastbound access to Victoria Hill from Royal and McBride.
 - All traffic travelling east along Royal and north on McBride, including buses, will access Victoria Hill via Memorial.
 - Westbound access out of Victoria Hill will be maintained via East Royal to McBride and Royal.
 - There will be a minor detour for Bus Route #102. Coast Mountain Bus Company will place advisory signs at any bus stops within Victoria Hill that are affected.
 - Emergency responder access will be maintained at East Royal.
 - A left-turn restriction from Memorial between 4 – 6 p.m. is not anticipated to be necessary; however, traffic conditions continue to be monitored.
- **“No U-turns” signage along Memorial** will be in place, in addition to traffic cones separating travel directions to prevent northbound vehicles on McBride from entering Memorial and attempting a U-turn within Victoria Hill to access the bridge.
- **Detour signage along Burnette Avenue near Braid and near Highway 1** will be in place to direct westbound vehicles on E. Columbia to E. 8th Street for access to the new bridge.

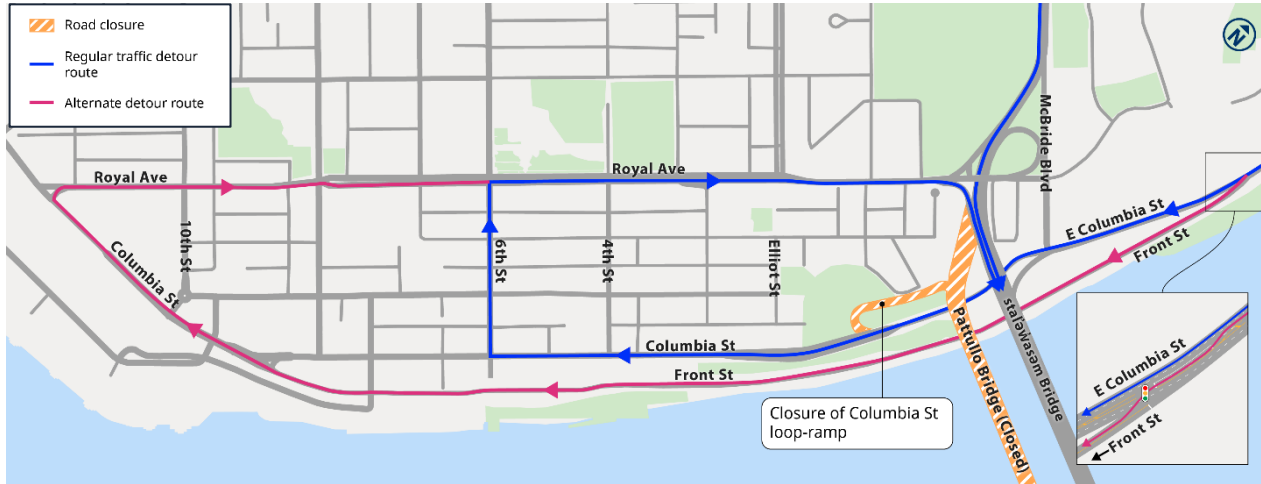

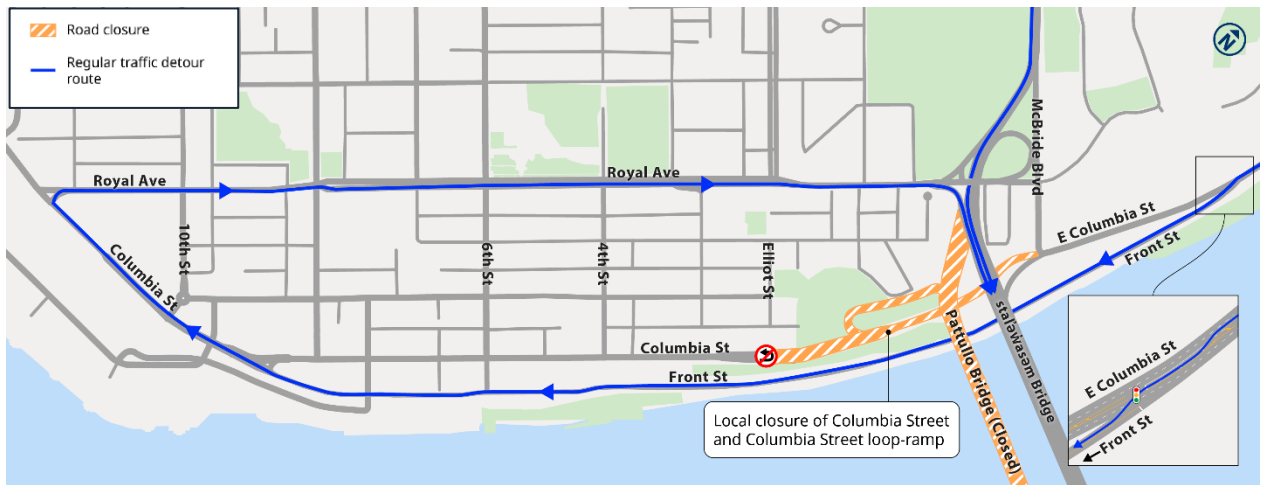


Regular Traffic Detour: Columbia Street Loop-ramp Closure
