



Southbound lane closure on the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge: May 7-11

Update: May 8, 2026

A southbound lane closure will be in effect on the stal'əwasəm Bridge from 9 p.m. on Thursday, May 7 until 5 a.m. on Monday, May 11. There will be one lane southbound and two lanes northbound open.

All traffic pattern changes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.

Crews are completing repairs from a localized fire at the south abutment as well as beginning works to widen the road at the south end of the bridge, which could not be completed until sections of the Pattullo Bridge were removed.

Starting at 9 p.m. on Thursday, May 7 until 5 a.m. on Monday, May 11.



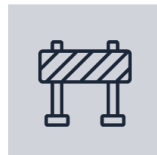
Hours of Work
