



Construction activities for Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass in New Westminster

May 20, 2026

Starting on Friday, May 22, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin construction of the new Agnes-Royal multi-use path overpass over the Bridge Connector and Royal Avenue on-ramp.

Nearby residents will hear noise associated with construction activities that involve the installation of steel girders, including bolting and pinning, for approximately two weeks.

To reduce impacts to bridge traffic, work activities will take place 24 hours a day, and over two weekends. Nighttime construction activities are required starting May 22. While crews will try to complete noisy activities during the day, some of these activities are sequential and will need to be completed at night, leading to nighttime noise.

Hours of Work

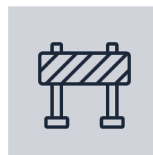
Work activities will take place 24 hours a day and over the weekends.
