



Weekend closure of the stal'əwasəm (Riverview) Bridge

May 22, 2026

Starting Friday, May 29 at 9 p.m., until Monday, June 1 at approximately 5 a.m., the stal'əwasəm Bridge will be closed in both directions for crews to complete installation of the multi-use path overpass superstructure over the Bridge Connector and Royal Avenue on-ramp in New Westminster.

Crews will also complete top lift paving of the multi-use path on the east side of the bridge, and milling and paving of King George Boulevard from the overspan on Scott Road to Bridgeview Drive.

stal'əwasəm Bridge users are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the weekend closure. N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges.

Access to businesses along King George Boulevard in Surrey and businesses in downtown New Westminster will be maintained.

All traffic pattern changes will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist as required. Information will also be communicated in advance via traffic media and posted on DriveBC.ca.

Starting Friday, May 29 at 9 p.m. until Monday, June 1 at approximately 5 a.m.



Hours of Work

Construction activities will take place 24 hours a day.



Traffic

The stal'əwasəm Bridge will be closed. Bridge users can take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the weekend closure. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist as required and traffic signage will be in place.



Impacts/Interruptions

stal'əwasəm Bridge users may experience longer than normal travel times due to weekend closure. Nearby residents will hear [noise associated with construction activities](#).
