



UPDATED: Overnight local closures of East Royal Avenue and lower McBride Boulevard

June 8, 2026

On Wednesday, June 10, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin final milling and paving works for approximately three nights on lower McBride Boulevard and at the East Royal-McBride intersection. This work was scheduled to start Monday, June 8 but has been postponed due to rainy weather. To complete this work, the following overnight traffic changes will be in effect:

Traffic impact	Date/Time	Detour (see map below for reference)
Overnight closures of East Royal Ave.	From Wednesday, June 10 to Saturday, June 13 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.	Access to Victoria Hill maintained via Memorial Drive. Drivers travelling northbound to access Victoria Hill can take Bridge Connector and Memorial Drive. Drivers travelling westbound on Royal Avenue or Columbia Street can take 6 th Street to 6 th Avenue, and McBride Boulevard to Memorial Drive to access Victoria Hill.
Overnight northbound closures of lower McBride Blvd.		Drivers travelling northbound on the stal'əwəsəm (Riverview) Bridge can take the East Columbia off-ramp to East Columbia Street, or Royal Avenue off-ramp to Royal Avenue.
Overnight southbound lane closures on lower McBride Blvd.		Drivers travelling eastbound on Royal Avenue can take McBride Boulevard southbound, and East or West Columbia Street. Access to one southbound lane will be maintained at all times.

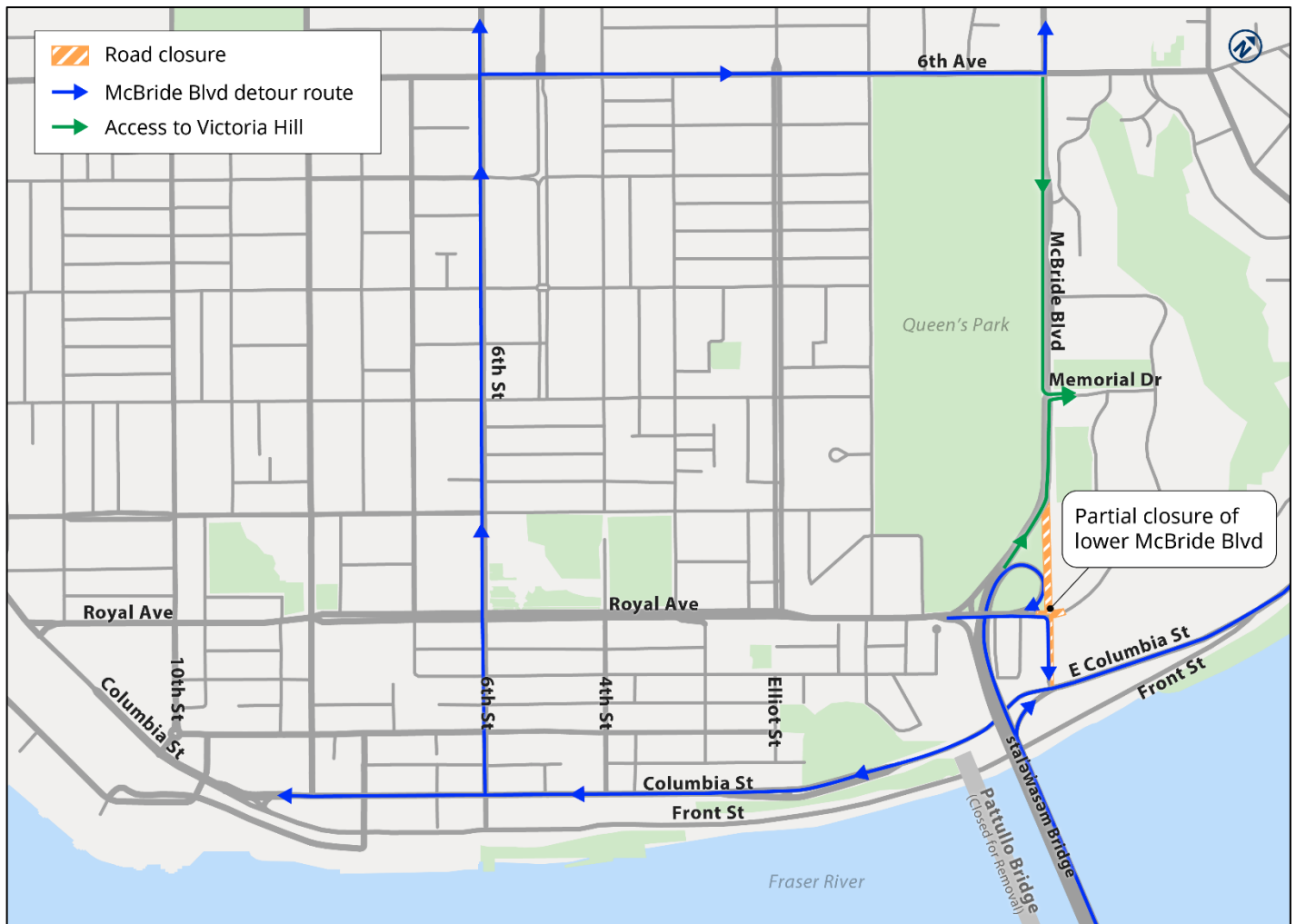
